What is edTPA?

A significant initiative

edTPA examines candidates' ability to demonstrate the Core of Effective Beginning Teaching (CEBT)

- edTPA, asks candidates to compile an electronic **Portfolio**
 - Featuring a **learning segment**: a 3-5 lesson unit
 - Broken down into 3 **tasks**
 - Planning Instruction & Assessment
 - Instructing & Engaging Students in Learning
 - Assessing Student Learning
 - Attention to academic language and analyzing teaching throughout
 - Documented with **evidence**
 - Candidate commentaries
 - Instructional artifacts, including student work
 - 1-2 unedited video clips of teacher-student interaction



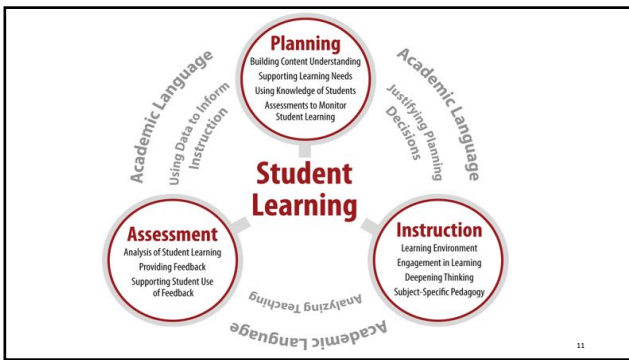



License as entitlement for completing a curriculum

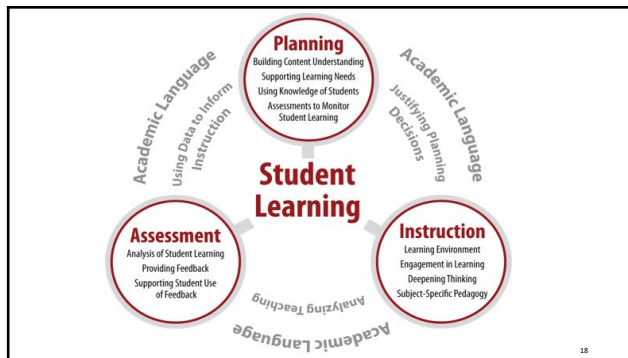
“But I’ve always wanted to be a teacher.”


